**Agreed Report**

- ✚ Minutes of previous meeting proposed and seconded.
- ✚ Child Safe-Guarding Oversight Report presented. One child protection issue reported to TUSLA. No further child protection or bullying issues to be reported under DE Child Safeguarding Procedures.
- ✚ Former student Sean Murphy celebrated Presentation Day Mass on 21st November and was presented with vestments bearing the Pres Sisters emblem. Huge thanks to all involved in preparing a lovely mass.
- ✚ School leaders training in the new anti-bullying procedures has taken place (Bí Cineálta).
- ✚ The 'We Mind' programme was presented to 6<sup>th</sup> Year by Jigsaw.
- ✚ Work continues with NEPs and EWO in relation to students needs and concerns.
- ✚ 6<sup>th</sup> Year, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 1<sup>st</sup> Year RSE workshops have taken place.
- ✚ Staff prayer service during start-up days
- ✚ Students have commenced leading morning reflections.
- ✚ JC exam results were exceptional – Congratulations to our students. The Board also acknowledged the hard work and dedication of staff in assisting our students to academic excellence and fulfilling their potential

- ✚ SNA review conducted by NCSE in November - Increase in regular SNA allocation to 3 WTE (+2 for ASD class). No confirmation on second ASD class yet. New appointments process is now complete.

- ✚ Enrolment for the Lighthouse Programme has commenced.
- ✚ Student council elections took place and this year's council appointed.
- ✚ TYs ran a basketball Blitz for both 1st and 2nd year students.
- ✚ Comhairle ns nÓg attend by members of the student council.
- ✚ Student Council ran Halloween events including a wellbeing dress-up day and 6 words story competition. Proceeds donated to the Red Cross Humanitarian Crisis in Gaza campaign.

- ✚ Boys' and girls' senior and cadet basketball has concluded for the year.
